

Chappaquiddick Community Center, Inc. Sailing Program Rules of Safety & Conduct

Fair Play - Team Cooperation- Good Sportsmanship

1. A swimming test must be passed each year.
2. US Coast Guard approved Type III Personal Flotation Devices (PFD's) must be worn by all participants while on the boats or in the water (except for swimming tests).
3. All participants while on boats or in the water must wear appropriate protective footwear.
4. Punctuality is expected.
5. Instructor's directions must be obeyed promptly whether by voice, whistle or flag.
6. Offensive behaviors or language will not be tolerated.
7. All vessels, supplies and equipment will be used safely and conscientiously and will not be abused.
8. All participants understand that the sailing beach is owned by the M.V. Land Bank and must be treated with care and respect.
9. Boats and equipment will be left in proper condition and stored appropriately at the end of each session. Any gear failure, breakage or damage will be reported to the Instructors before the end of each session.
10. The beach will be policed at the end of each session and left clean and orderly. The CCC is not responsible for personal items left on beach property. All personal items will be taken home daily.
11. Sailors must strive to develop competency in safety drills, capsizing, towing and rescue procedures.

I have read and understand The Chappaquiddick Community Center's Sailing Program's Rules of Safety and Conduct. I agree to conduct myself accordingly and understand that failure to follow them may result in expulsion from the class and in the event of repeated violations, expulsion from the program.
